

Step by step guide on how to download and test the BEXAM Alpha Wallet

Important: In order to test the wallet, we will be giving you **FAKE** BXA and BTC. These tokens are not real and have no value, but are simply for the purpose of testing the wallet.


Of course, this is only an Alpha build of the BEXAM wallet and the final product will be changed before release. Downloading the BEXAM Wallet

1. Download the file from the BEXAM.io website
2. Unzip the file to your computer
3. Open the file named bexam-wallet



Navigating the BEXAM Wallet

Account: Displays the basic information such as funds balance and related history.

Funds: Displays the user's wallet addresses as well as allows the user to withdraw funds to other wallets.


Trade: Allows for making basic trades with other users.

Sending BXA or BTC


First add a wallet address for funds to be sent to:

Within the **Funds** tab choose the **Register Address** submenu.

1. Choose either BXA or BTC for the destination wallet in the dropdown menu
2. Fill in the Label for the wallet address being saved (ex. Jeff's Wallet).
3. Input the wallet's address in the address field
4. Click register




5. A pop-up will appear asking for confirmation, click register again.




Sending Funds to another wallet:

Within the **Funds** tab choose the **Withdrawal** submenu.

1. Choose the currency to send from the dropdown menu
2. Choose the wallet to send funds from the dropdown menu
3. Input the amount of funds to send
4. Click the Submit button



5. A pop-up confirmation will appear, click register again.



Making a Trade

Our wallet Alpha build allows for simple trades to be made between users. This portion will get a huge overhaul before launch and is included now just to test functionality and speeds of trading currencies between users.

Within the Trade tab choose the Exchange submenu

1. Choose which currency you would like to Buy or Sell
2. Choose whether you would like to Buy or Sell
3. Input the Asking/Offering Price per Token, the amount to Buy/Sell, and the total price will appear automatically. Alternatively, you can input the Asking/Offering Price per Token and the Total price and the amount will automatically appear.
4. Click the Open Buy Order Button.


STEP 1 points to the 'BTC / BXA' dropdown menu.

STEP 2 points to the 'BUY BTC' button.

STEP 3 points to the 'Price' input field.

STEP 4 points to the 'Open Buy Order' button.

5. A pop-up will appear asking for confirmation, click the send button.



All open trades will appear in the tables on this screen. The trade offers in red are open orders from users that wish to sell a currency. The trade offers in green are open orders from users that wish to buy a currency.
